Rhonda Jackson Scholarship – Named in the honor of the late wife of Mr. Thomas “Jet” Jackson, a longtime member of the Delta Omicron Sigma Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. Mrs. Jackson participated in countless community service events and projects in St. Petersburg, including as coordinator of the MLK National Drum Major for Justice Parade and Battle of the Bands. She also was a tutor and helped establish the tutoring program at the St. Mark Missionary Baptist Church, where she was a member for many years. Two (2) recent high school graduates receive a \$500 scholarship. **AWARDED IN JULY.**

Fred G. Minnis & Louis D. Brown Sr. Scholarship - Named in honor of two of our charter chapter members. Fred G. Minnis was the first black full-time lawyer in Pinellas County, Fla. Mr. Minnis began practicing law in 1956. He headed the law firm that represented the Citizens Cooperative Committee, the NAACP, and the NAACP Youth Council in their many legal actions in the 1950s and 1960s. The Fred G. Minnis Sr. Bar Association was founded in 2000 and is the only predominately African American voluntary bar association in Pinellas. Mr. Minnis also served as state director and a national officer for Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity Inc.

Louis D. Brown Sr. was an educator in Pinellas County from the 1950s through 1970s. He held many roles in the school system, including teacher and administrator at Gibbs High School, principal at then-Wildwood Elementary School and assistant principal at Sixteenth Street Middle School until his retirement from the Pinellas County School system in 1973. In 1980, Mr. Brown founded Lou Brown Realty with his son Louis D. Brown Jr. to serve the African American community. One (1) college student will receive a \$500 scholarship. **AWARDED IN NOVEMBER**

Invicta Athletics offers measurable behavioral development programs that promote good health, fitness, and wellness. The programs are designed to directly assist in the reduction of childhood obesity, delinquency, and crime among youth in our community.
